Proceedings:

- a. At the outset Dr Sujata Mangaraj, Regional Vice President (East), AIMS welcomed all the members present.
- b. It was followed by a discussion on activities already conducted/to be conducted for the period 1st September 2018 to 31st August 2019. With active participation and exchange of views by all the members of ERC, a comprehensive calendar of activities for the above period was finalised and the same is annexed as below:

- c. Reference was drawn to the mail received from Ms. Rupinder Kaur, on AIMS membership and ATMA enrolment (copy enclosed) of 17 Business Schools in Eastern India. In this connection, this is to report here that out of 17 institutions, the three institutions in Odisha have already

been contacted by Dr Sujata Mangaraj and two of them i.e., IMI and BGU have consented to become members of AIMS. Prof R K Patra and Prof R C Bhattacharya from West Bengal Chapter will coordinate the ten institutions from the states of West Bengal and Assam. The remaining four institutions will be coordinated by Prof N P Singh.

- d. Discussion was also made for setting up the Eastern Region Office premises at Bhubaneswar. Prof (Dr) Prabir Pal, the Past President AIMS informed the members that the matter will be moved to Government of Odisha for allocation of half acre of land at a cost of Rs. 1.5 crores per acre. All AIMS activities including training, conference, seminar, meetings etc, can be housed in the building constructed on the land. Necessary approval is sought from the esteemed Executive Board for the same.
- e. It was also decided to convene a meeting of all the member institutions at chapter level to initiate and expedite membership drive in Eastern Region.
- f. The meeting concluded with vote of thanks proposed by Prof P K Tripathy.
