**GUIDELINES**

1. All students of full-time MBA, MMS, MPM, MCM, MMM, PGD programmes of two-year duration of member Institution of AIMS are eligible to participate in the competition. Each participant can submit only one paper. **(Annual Member – PI renew your AIMS Membership, if not done already). Non-Member Institutions can also participate subject to bearing costs of their stay and travel.**
2. The paper should normally be restricted to a maximum of around 20 pages, excluding Appendix. An executive summary of the paper in 1.5 line spacing, not exceeding two pages, must also be sent along with the paper. The paper should be routed through the Head of the Institution.

The paper should be an original contribution on any of the following sub themes of 29th AIMS Annual Convention:

- Managing Transition: National and International Perspective in Management Education
- Management Education for a Borderless World
- Managing Distortions in Management Education: a Global Perspective
- Re-engineering the curriculum to cater to the revolutionary and emerging management innovations in India and abroad
- Collaborations of management institutions with foreign universities
- Digital and ICT impact on socio-economic scenario across the globe
- Data Analytics
- E-Governance and regulatory issues, and
- Accreditation

The paper should not have been submitted for any award earlier.

3. Participants should submit a soft copy of the paper (a PDF file) through email to each of the following Jury and to the Secretariat at [aimsconvention2017@gmail.com](mailto:aimsconvention2017@gmail.com), (entered in 1.5 line spacing with appropriate margin using Times New Roman font size 12) along with a brief profile of the author(s).
4. The last date for receipt of the papers is **29th July, 2017**.
5. There will be two (2) prizes in this competition.
6. Six best entries will be invited to be presented at the **29<sup>th</sup> AIMS Annual Management Education Convention** to be held at **Pune**. They will also be invited to participate in the Convention as guests and in addition to local hospitality will be reimbursed AC (III) tire return train fare by the shortest route. **Participants from non-member institutions will not be provided accommodation and fare reimbursement.** Food at the Convention Venue is allowed as guests.
