AIMS NATIONAL MANAGEMENT WEEK AWARD

ELIGIBILITY FOR PARTICIPATION

- ❖ AIMS Member Institutions are eligible to participate in the competition by celebrating AIMS National Management Week from 13th to 18th October 2025 (either on all the days or some of the days during this period).
- ❖ Non-member institutions can also participate subject to bearing their own costs of stay and travel.

RULES & GUIDELINES

 Each participating institution should submit a report through online google form available in AIMS website on the proceedings, giving a brief account of the various activities taken up during the specified period only, and the report should not exceed 20 (twenty) pages in 1.5 line spacing in Times New Roman font 12, including some important photos.

Some of the suggested topics which can be taken up for the celebration purpose are as follows:

- i. Rural and community development activities
- ii. Education, Healthcare, spirituality, including meditation and yoga
- iii. Contribution by hospitals, old-age homes, prison and orphanages
- iv. Sustainable development practices
- v. Awareness activities on Indian Knowledge system
- vi. Promotion of local/ Regional food and cultural practices.
- 2. Participants should submit a Report in video form as per size specified supported by a pdf file as attachment in the google form (using Times New Roman, font size 12). The last date for receipt of the report is 15th October 2025.

3. Publicity:

- (a) Chapter leaders will be requested by RVP of respective zones for giving wide publicity amongst students in the chapter and institution level.
- (b) Wide publicity shall be provided through social media at the headquarters level for popularizing this event
- 4. There will be **two awards** in this competition for the top four institutions (one best selected from each zone).
- After initial screening by the Jury, one faculty and one student for each selected Institutions will be invited to make a final presentation in physical mode of their programs at the AIMS Annual Convention:2025 to be held at SOA University, Bhubaneswar, Odisha on 11th December 2025.

6. **Two** selected institution (out of four invited) will be awarded Memento and Certificates other contestants shall be issued Participation Certificate.
