

AIMS MANAGEMENT SCHOLAR AWARD - 2026

GUIDELINES

The Association of Indian Management Schools has instituted an award to recognize young management scholars who have excelled in teaching, research, consulting, etc. This award aims to identify and encourage young faculty to continue their efforts in management education. We request the Deans and Directors of the B-schools to encourage your faculty to apply for the award.

Eligibility:

1. Full-time Faculty Members below the age of 45, working in any Business School including IIMs, Management Departments of IITs, NITs and Central, State, Deemed and Private Universities, who have done outstanding research work in the area of Management, Published Research Papers in FT50 / ABDC / SCOPUS indexed / WoS indexed / High Impact factor Journals and have undertaken quality research & consulting projects & developed innovative courseware are eligible to participate in the competition.
2. Each Institute may nominate only one faculty member. A soft copy in a PDF file should only be submitted online form (<https://forms.gle/RWJEPtGpFZkmQVwS8>).

4. The nomination should be routed through the Head of the Institution and should include a personal assessment by the Head of the Institution of the nominee highlighting the standing of the candidate in the profession as management educator.
5. The last date for submission of the nominations is **15th July, 2026**.
6. The Management Scholar 2026 awardee will be felicitated and receive a Memento and a citation at the 37th AIMS Foundation Day at XIME, Bangalore on 29th August, 2026.
7. S/he will also be invited to participate in the Foundation Day Event as a guest and will be reimbursed for AC (II) tier return train fare by the shortest route in addition to local hospitality.
